

Video Descriptions

1. 2010 Email or Fax Orders – Shows how to send electronic order copies to a customer – performed as requested by customer
2. 2010 QB User End of Day for Import of Estimates – Shows to process orders that will be electronically imported into QuickBooks – normally end of day process
3. 2010 End of Day Std 1 and 2 – Shows how to process orders for non-QuickBooks clients – normally end of day process for non-QuickBooks clients
4. 2010 Load OM PDA with Cust and Prod Data – Shows how to download data into the Palm OS PDA scanner – normally a start of day task to be done immediately after refreshing data into OrderMaster from the corporate system (such as QuickBooks) – follow video #6 below
5. 2010 Load OM Program into PDA – Shows how to load the OrdPad program into the Palm OS PDA scanner – as needed if batteries run down in scanner
6. 2010 QB User Load OM with QB Data – Shows how to load OrderMaster with the most current QuickBooks data: Reps, Customers, & Products/Price - normally a start of day task that is done first thing or at least Monday, Wednesday, & Friday. OR when product/price changes
7. 2010 Manual Order Entry – Shows how to create a new order without a scanner via PC data entry – as needed
8. 2010 Print Labels – Shows how to print labels with OrderMaster. Custom labels are printed from the WASP labeler program after exporting data from OrderMaster into a .dbf file instead of direct print from OrderMaster – as needed
9. 2010 Scanned Order Entry 1/2/3 – Shows how to process an order after it has been scanned into a Palm OS PDA scanner – as needed. NOTE: this video shows how to also maintain and print orders
10. 2010 Taking Orders Janam Handheld – Shows how to process an order on the Janam or Palm T/X handheld scanner
